I. Easter proves that a _____ savior can never save!

“Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?” Vs. 12

“But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised.” Vs. 13

“And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain.” Vs. 14
- **Christianity is just another _____.**
“We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified about God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised.” Vs. 15
- **Jesus Christ cannot _____ your soul.**
“And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.” Vs. 17

- **Christians who have died are hopelessly _____ forever.**
"Then those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished."

"If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied." Vs. 19
